The Langham Dome Trainer is a Scheduled Ancient Monument and is officially Norfolk's youngest. Several were built during World War 2 but only a handful remains and we must preserve this crucial piece of WW2 history.

The aim is to restore the Dome, install the original equipment and create a car park and Visitor & Education Centre as a memorial to those that flew from Langham never to return but for this we need to secure funding and this is where you can help.
